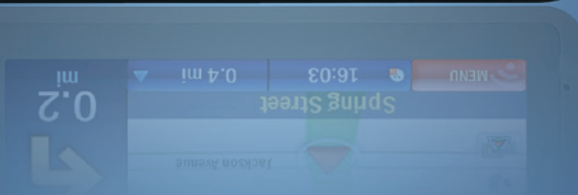

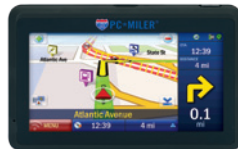
## Thank you for choosing PC\*MILER Navigator.

# Getting Started

## 2. To Assemble the Windshield Mount



- Attach clip to mount.
- Place mount against windshield.
- Before attaching to windshield ensure lever is in unlock position (away from suction cup toward clip).
- Put suction cup on windshield and press lever into lock position (**down** toward base of mount) to secure.



### WARNING!

Please check state and local traffic laws before mounting. Minnesota state laws prohibit drivers from using suction mounts on their windshields while operating a motor vehicle.

# Getting Started

## 3. To Attach the Truck Charger



- Connect USB end of charger to the USB port on the PC\*MILER Navigator.
- Connect opposite end into truck power port.
- **NOTE:** Unit should remain plugged in and powered at all times.

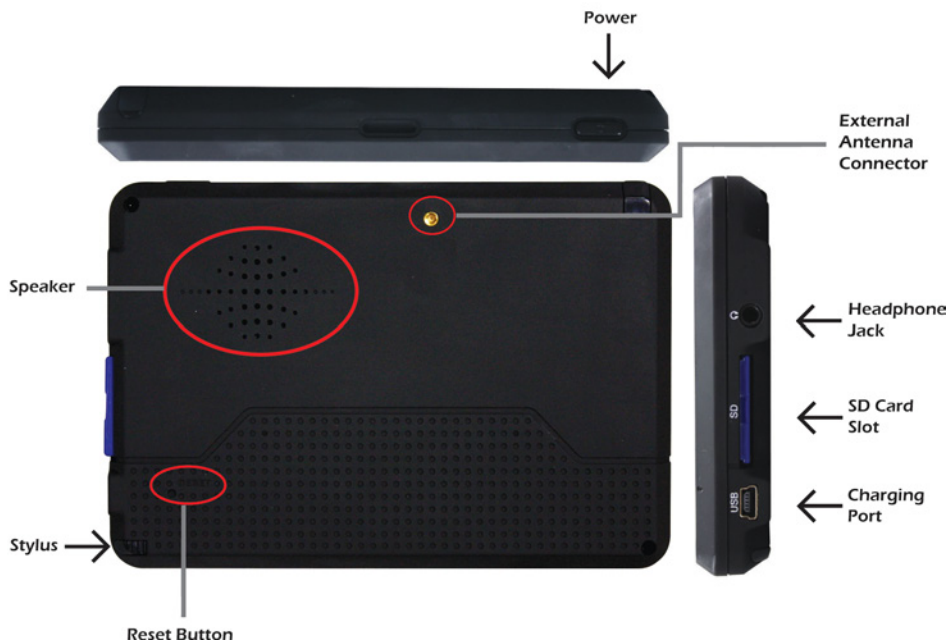


### FOR YOUR SAFETY



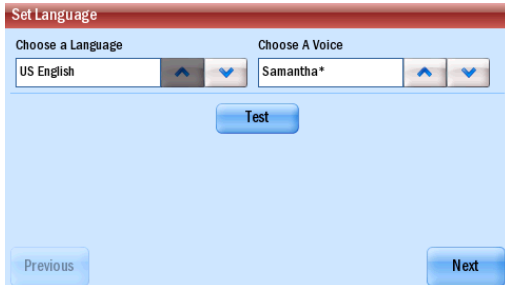
## FOR YOUR SAFETY

## 5. Select Language and Voice

- Set the language for on-screen text and voice guidance then tap **NEXT**. Select **Samantha\*** to have street names read aloud.



## 6. Select a Distance Measurement

- Choose between Miles and Kilometers (km) for distances. Tap **NEXT**.



## 7. Safety Warning

You will be asked to accept the Safety Warning for PC\*Navigator.

- Click **Accept** to continue.

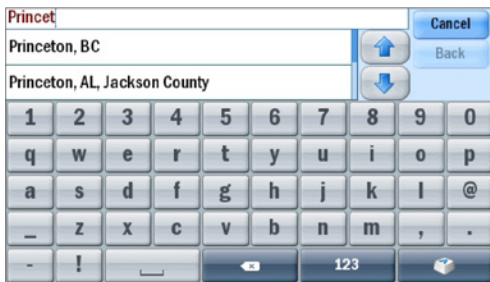

# First Trip

## Selecting a Destination

PC\*MILER Navigator uses GPS Satellites to calculate your exact position so you don't have to enter your starting point. Simply enter your destination and PC\*MILER Navigator will take you there, providing detailed dock-to-dock voice guided instructions.

- Tap **Menu > Destination > Address**.
- Enter the city/town name of your destination.
- Select the correct city or area when it appears in the list below the city field. .
- Enter the first three or four letters of the street name. Tap to view the autofilled addresses and select the correct street name when it appears.
- Enter the house/building number and select **Finish**, or just select **Finish** to skip this step when no house/building number is available.
- A screen will then appear, showing you a map of the route. Select **Drive** to begin navigating your route.

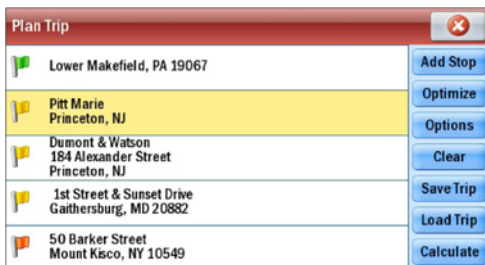

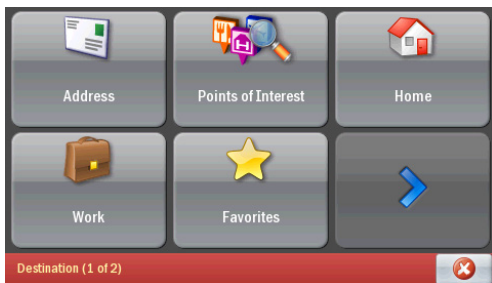

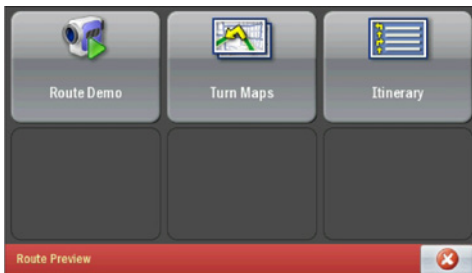

## FOR YOUR SAFETY


Do not attempt to change the settings, or set a destination on the PC\*MILER Navigator while driving. Ask a passenger to make changes, or pull over safely. Do not leave your device loose in the cab while driving. Ensure it is correctly placed in the windshield mount.

## Change the Driving View

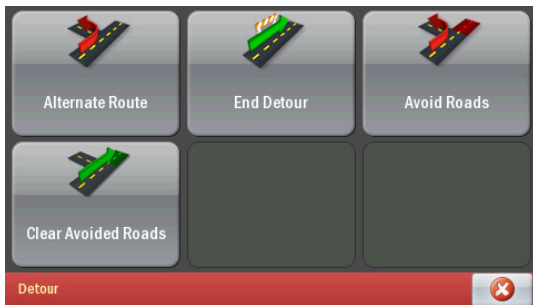


# On the Move

## Take a Detour

PC\*MILER Navigator can detour from your current itinerary. You can choose an alternate route, or just detour around a section of the route.

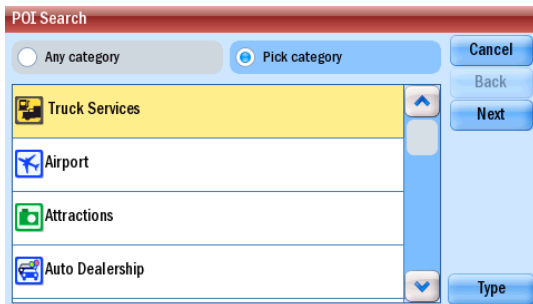
- Select **Menu > Detour**

## Search for a Point of Interest

If you are running low on diesel fuel or need to rest at a truck stop, PC\*MILER Navigator has millions of pre-loaded Points-of-Interest (POI) to search.

- Tap **Menu > Nearby POI**
